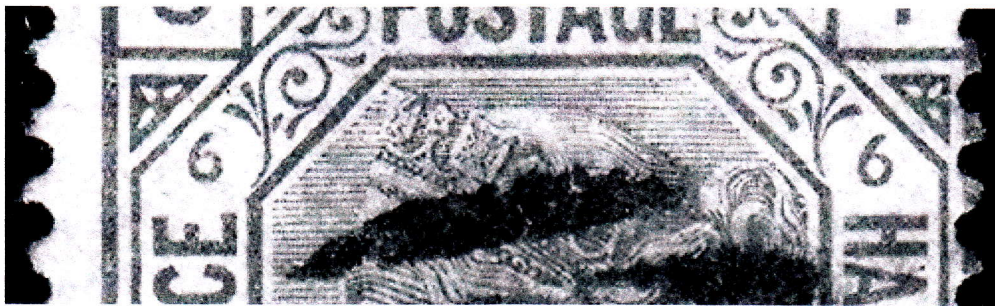

WATERMARK LARGE ANCHOR FOR PLATES 1 TO 3, WATERMARK ORB FOR PLATES 3 TO 17 AND 17 TO 20 AND WATERMARK IMPERIAL CROWN FOR PLATES 21 TO 23. SPECIMENS WITH INVERTED WATERMARK FOR PLATES 1 TO 3 AND 17 TO 20 ARE KNOWN.

COLOUR ROSE FOR PLATES 1 TO 17 AND BLUE FOR PLATES 17 TO 23.
