PLATES OF 20 ROWS OF 12 STAMPS OF ONE PENNY. PLATES 69, 70, 75, 126 AND 128 WERE PREPARED BUT REJECTED OWING TO DEFECTS. PLATE 77 WAS ALSO REJECTED BUT SOME STAMPS PRINTED FROM IT WERE USED (ABOUT 7 OR 8 ARE KNOWN). PLATES 226 TO 228 WERE MADE BUT NOT USED. RE-ENTRIES IN THIS ISSUE ARE FEW: MK AND TK OF PLATE 71 AND SL AND TL OF PLATE 83.

LETTERS IN ALL FOUR CORNERS. IN IDENTIFYING STAMPS LOWER LETTERS ARE QUOTED. DOUBLE LETTERS ARE KNOWN.

PERFORATION 14. IMPERFORATES KNOWN TO EXIST.
